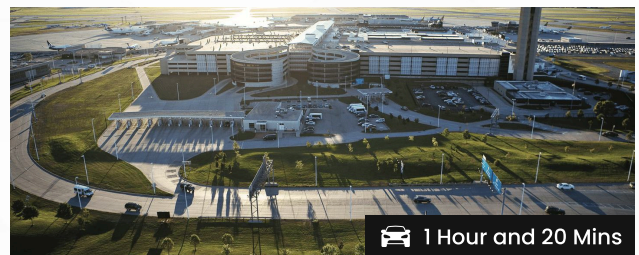

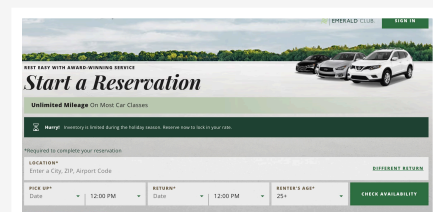

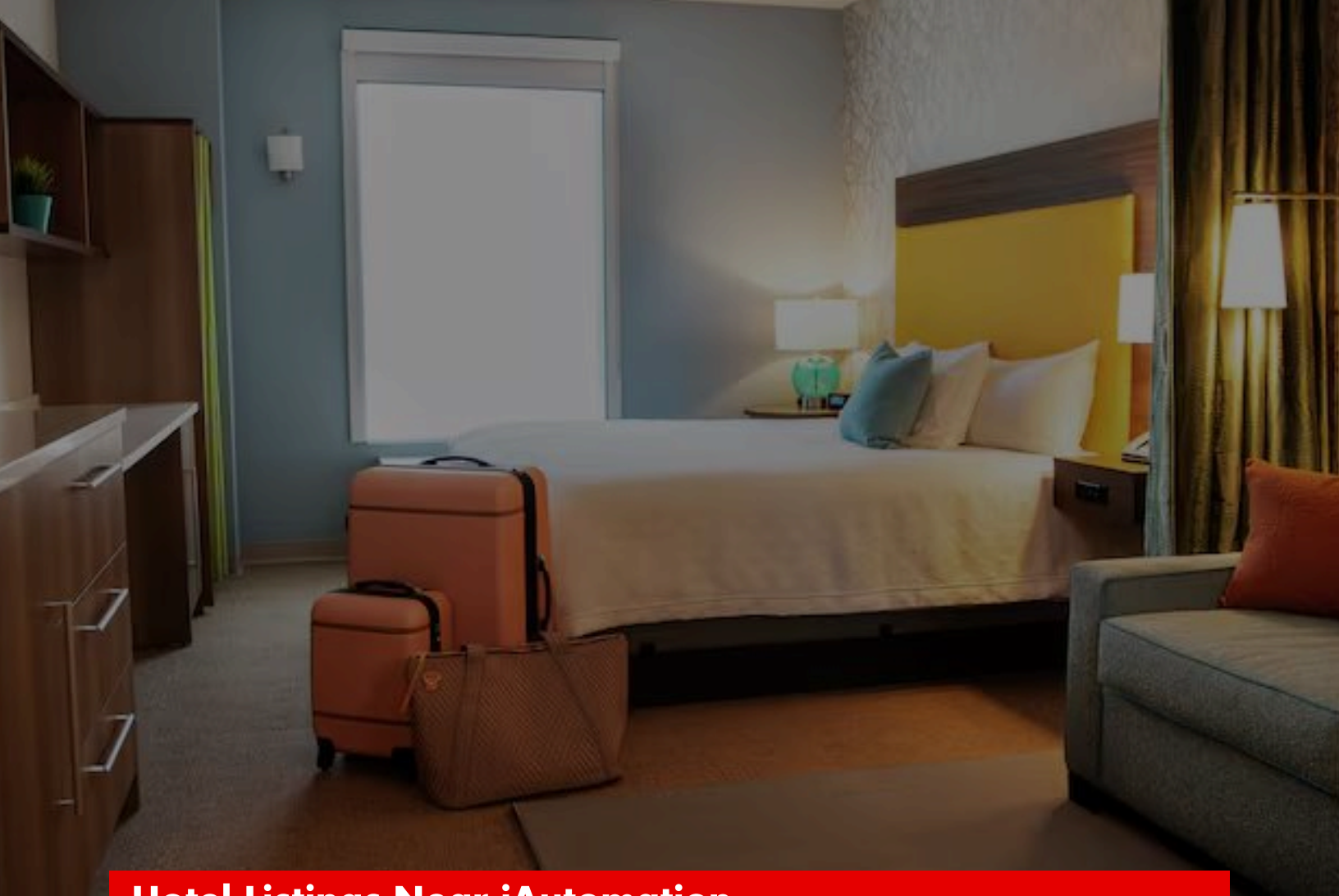

Local Sights

01 Lakeside Park

Scenic park right on Lake Winnebago with a lighthouse, walking paths, playgrounds, boat launch, and picnic areas. Great for a relaxing outdoor break.

03 Thelma Sadoff Center for the Arts (THELMA)

A member-based, privately funded nonprofit offering intimate concerts and arts experiences, including street concerts with major performers. Good for culture and live music.

05 LaClare Farm

An award-winning goat cheese farm with a shop and scratch-made cafe; visitors can cuddle goats and watch the milking process around 4:30 pm. Fun, low-key stop for foodies.

07 Fond du Lac Dock Spiders game

Catch a Northwoods League baseball game at Herr-Baker Field for a classic summer-night outing.

02 Road America (Elkhart Lake)

A must for motorsports fans. Beyond car racing, Road America offers off-roading, go-karting, zip-lining, and driving schools, with scenic foliage views. About 25 minutes away.

04 Historic Galloway House and Village

A living-history village with restored 19th-century buildings; also transforms into a haunted attraction in the fall led by a masked, silent guide through the buildings and grounds.

06 Mascoutin Valley State Trail / Wild Goose State Trail

A 12-mile crushed-stone trail connecting Ripon and Berlin, tree-lined and mostly flat, good for biking or hiking with benches along the way.

08 Kohler-Andrae State Park / Whistling Straits (day trip)

About 30–40 minutes away: Kohler-Andrae offers miles of sandy dunes, forest trails, and Lake Michigan beach access, while Whistling Straits is a renowned links-style golf course with rugged bluff views.
